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Autodesk® Fusion 360 Manage with Upchain Offering Unification FAQ

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1. General information

1.1 What is happening?

Autodesk is unifying the primary offerings of Fusion 360® Manage and Upchain together. On August 7, 2022, the purchase of licenses of the standalone products will no longer be available. The unification of these two product lines enables Autodesk customers to purchase a single, comprehensive, full cloud Product Data Management & Product Lifecycle Management solution. There are no subsequent changes to the Vault or Vault PLM or Fusion 360 Manage Extension product offerings with this announcement.

1.2 Why is this good for Autodesk customers?

Manufacturing today demands a product design solution that merges PDM with PLM to provide capabilities to achieve improvement in collaboration, product development agility, and supply chain agility... as well as potentially reduce non value-add processes, reduce product errors, and accelerate time to market. Unifying Fusion 360 Manage with Upchain gives customers CAD-integrated PDM capabilities along with the ability to extend access to data and critical information across the organization with cloud PLM.

Autodesk is on a strategic journey to bring our solutions and customers onto a single platform. By bringing Fusion 360 Manage and Upchain together, we take one step forward in Autodesk's vision to stitch together the core of a unified data & process management solution, bringing customers closer to achieving a comprehensive digital thread.

2. Key dates and transition support

2.1 What transition options do I have if I am a current Fusion 360 Manage or Upchain subscriber?

Customers with an active subscription of Fusion 360 Manage or Upchain will switch to a unified offering during their natural subscription renewal occurring after August 7, 2022. Your Autodesk Sales Representative or Reseller will guide you through the process.

2.2 When is the last day to buy standalone Fusion 360 Manage or standalone Upchain subscriptions?

The last day to buy new or renewal standalone Fusion 360 Manage subscriptions or standalone Upchain subscriptions is on August 6, 2022.

2.3 What will the new unified offerings give me access to?

The unified primary offerings will give you access to products from both product lines. The standalone offerings are paired together based upon corresponding workflows and functionality:

The unified offering will entitle you with access to the appropriate level of the two products, Fusion 360 Manage and Upchain, for the subscription you purchase. If you are an Account Admin, the entitlements will require reassignment in Accounts to specific end, Named Users.
